The U.S. EPA’s Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule (40 CFR 745.80 through 92 - the “RRP Rule”) which was promulgated in April 2008, is now fully effective in Massachusetts. Mickey Laskey, Code Enforcement Inspector, for DPH’s CLPPP, will discuss how renovation, repair and painting work must be conducted in older residences and child-occupied facilities in the state and its impact on enforcement.
